## **Significant Actions**

Due to Covid-19 and travel restrictions, Spring Leadership and TRIO Day were cancelled. This resulted in no money being spent from these line items. Additionally, SWASAP Board Meeting, SWASAP ELI, AASAP Board Meeting and AASAP ELI all had little to no use of funds allocated. Overall, this will result in a surplus of funds for the year.

# 2020 AASAP Regional and National Issues Committee Report Lacey Gebhart

February 10, 2020: Betsy DeVos and the Trump Administration moved to consolidate and cut TRIO by 13%. Trump Administration released the President's Fiscal Year 2021 budget request to Congress. Overall, this budget slashes funding for U.S. Department of Education programs by \$5.6 billion or 8%.

March 24-25, 2020 COE held a virtual Policy Seminar. TRIO professionals from Arkansas were able to meet with all our members of Congress to advocate for our students.

April 1, 2020 Congress passed Emergency Funding for COVID-19 Crisis, including Education. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) was signed into law on March 27, 2020. It includes \$12.56 billion to colleges, based mostly on their share of students with Pell grants.

June 30, 2020 The Senate introduced COVID-19 Proposal with \$450 million for TRIO. Senator Patty Murray (D-WA) and colleagues introduced the Coronavirus Child Care and Education Relief Act (CCCERA), a proposed COVID-19 emergency education funding bill to provide \$450 million in emergency support for federal TRIO programs to serve low-income/first-generation students, unemployed adults, and students with disabilities.

COE's Annual Policy Seminar is scheduled for March 21-24, 2021, in Washington DC. This is an amazing opportunity to advocate for TRIO students! Please consider attending and letting our Arkansas legislators know that TRIO works!
